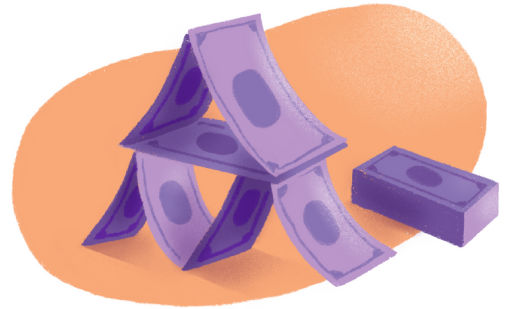

Support the Evergreen Basic Income Program, HB 1045

A 2-year pilot Guaranteed Basic Income (GBI) program would provide **monthly, unconditional, and unrestricted cash payments** to offer participants greater freedom, dignity, and choice in caring for themselves and their families.



This program is based on existing community-driven pilot programs and the statewide GBI feasibility study, which show that GBI improves food security, mental health, poverty rates, employment rates, and child development.

- The pilot program is designed to reflect geographic variations in costs of living - participants would receive a monthly payment equal to the cost of rent for a 2-bedroom unit in their area of residence
- Program eligibility would be open to all adult Washington residents (18 years old or older) whose income is at or below 200% of the federal poverty level
- The program is designed to prevent loss of other benefits by providing exemptions in other programs, financial counseling, and funding to directly reimburse any loss
